## COLORED PENCILS: WAX BASED

There are professional and student grades and you get what you pay for in the art supply world. Some brands can be purchased in "open stock". Pencil sets start with 12 basic colors and go up to 150+ color sets that include warm, cool and French greys as well as fluorescent and metallic.

## COLORED PENCILS: WATER SOLUBLE

There are professional and student grades here to. There are two types, water color, graphite and ink.

## SHARPING YOUR COLORED PENCILS

You can start with a simple fixed blade tool the size of a piece of candy. This type also comes battery powered. Or you can go to the top of the food chain and buy an electric model, it's time and money. There are a number of good models that are hand crank types.

## PLATFORMS: WHAT TO DRAW ON

Wax based colored pencils can be used on 70lb. papers that is if you prefer a light touch technique. I prefer 90lb. to 140lb. and don't be afraid of working on colored stock or Illustration Board. Water soluble colored pencils can be used on paper starting at 140lb. Try 300lb. water color paper and Illustration Board.
