

Drawing On the Right Side of The Brain

REQUIRED DRAWING MATERIALS:

- Some drawing paper.
- Soft drawing pencil
 - 4B is good.
- An art eraser.
- Some masking or Scotch tape.
- A small, hand-held pencil sharpener.
- A piece of clear plastic, about 8" x 10" and about 1/16" thick.
 - A piece of glass is fine, but the edges must be taped.
- Two "viewfinders," made of cardboard about 8" x 10".
 - Razor blade for cutting viewfinder.
 - From one, we will cut a rectangular opening of $4\frac{1}{4}$ x $5\frac{1}{4}$ and from the other, we'll cut out a larger opening of 6 x $7\frac{5}{8}$.
- Two clips to fasten your viewfinders to the plastic picture plane.
- Useful but not necessary:
 - Charcoal pencils
 - Retractable utility knife
 - Colored pencils
 - Black ballpoint pen
 - 18" ruler,
 - Newsprint (18" x 24")
 - Strathmore 400 lb. drawing pad (18" x 24")
