

Timely Notification Bulletin

Potential Threat to the Community
"Your Right to Know"
March 4, 2008

In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal **Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998** the Yavapai College Police is giving notice of a potential for an act of violence reported to have occurred at the Career and Technical Education Center (CTEC).



Reported Offense

On February 29, 2008, the Yavapai College Police Department received information that Mr. Frank Creelman was involved in multiple verbal altercations with employees at CTEC between February 12, 2008, and February 15, 2008. During these verbal altercations, apparently threats of violence toward the employees were made. The College Police Department is currently investigating these altercations. Mr. Creelman has been served with a temporary Restraining Order (Injunction Against Harassment) and has been restricted from coming onto any Yavapai College Campus or Property.

Description

White male; 60's; 5'11"; 195 lbs.; long, grey, braided hair; long grey beard; glasses. See attached photo.

Vehicle known to drive

1980 American Motor Home • AZ License H/C CR817

It can be assumed that conditions continue to exist that may pose a threat to members and guests of the community. It is the duty of the institution to warn of possible "dangerous conditions" on or near its campus, and at affiliate organizations off campus; an "affirmative duty"

exists to warn persons associated with this college of possible peril at the hands of some third party or parties.
