TIMELY NOTIFICATION BULLETIN
Potential Threat to the Community
“Your Right to Know”
December 19, 2007

In compliance with the “Timely Notice” provisions of the federal **Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998** the Yavapai College Police are giving notice of a potential for an act of violence reported to have occurred on the Prescott Campus of Yavapai College.



REPORTED OFFENSE:

On December 17, 2007, during a domestic dispute, Andreas Linakis was reported to have been verbally threatening to his spouse and a worker in Building 4. Yavapai College Police Department continues to investigate the incident. Andrea Linakis has been criminally trespassed from Yavapai College by Yavapai College Police Department. Andreas Linakis continues to text message his spouse and was also seen driving the below-described Red Mazda on Sheldon Street on December 18, 2007.

Description:

White male, 5’8”, 145 lbs., close cropped hair, brown eyes, brown hair, goatee.

Vehicles known to drive: **2004 Red Mazda Miata MX5**
AZ Temporary Plate – BT24392

2004 White Chevrolet Silverado, ¾ Ton P/U
AZ License Plate – 457AKD
(with ladder racks, one painted blue and one painted red; the front grill is painted red.)

It can be assumed that conditions continue to exist that may pose a threat to members and guests of the community. It is the duty of the institution to warn of possible “dangerous conditions” on or near its campus, and at affiliate

organizations off campus; an “affirmative duty” exists to warn persons associated with this college of possible peril at the hands of some third party or parties.
