

Community Scholars Program

The community scholars program will enable Yavapai College students to take upper-level coursework offered by accredited institutions of higher learning. The scholarship will pay \$180 per credit hour for a maximum of \$1080 per student (six credit hours). This scholarship will enable Yavapai College students to explore upper-level coursework in subjects of their choice and get a head start on their baccalaureate degree program. Funds available for 2009/2010 are made available by the Yavapai College Foundation.

Community Scholars Eligibility Criteria:

Students must:

1. be currently enrolled at Yavapai College (full-time or part-time).
2. have completed at least 30 hours of college-level coursework at Yavapai College.
3. have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
4. intend to pursue a baccalaureate degree.
5. be willing and able to pay the difference in tuition and any fees.
6. provide a cover letter defining educational goals and how the scholarship will help achieve your objectives.

Preference will be given to:

1. Full-time students.
2. Degree-seeking students.
3. Students with joint admission or accepted for admission by the transfer institution.
4. Students taking courses taught in partnership with Yavapai College.

The Community Scholars' application form is available at www.yc.edu/financialaid/. Submission of a scholarship application is required. A committee of faculty and staff will make scholarship award decisions.
