

# How to Apply

The Yavapai College Honors Program is competitive. Admission is based on scholastic achievement and on demonstrated ability to think critically and independently.

## **Students are required to Meet Academic Requirements**

***Due Date for Completion of All Steps Listed; Below is March 1st of the Application year.***

Students new to Yavapai College will need to complete an application for admission.

Students must submit all application materials in **one packet** either electronically or in one clearly marked envelope with the student's name and attention:

**College Honors Program.** The Financial Aid department will not accept the application unless it comes in as one packet with the exception of the letters of recommendation.

## **A complete application packet for the College Honors requires the submission of all of the following:**

1. A letter of interest as described in the application guidelines
2. A critical essay as detailed in the application guidelines
3. Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from an academic source. Ask your recommenders to label the letter with your name and attention: **College Honors Program** and send the letters electronically to [Prescott.financial.aid@yc.edu](mailto:Prescott.financial.aid@yc.edu)
4. One of the following to demonstrate eligibility as described in the application guidelines (Scan if you are sending electronically):
  - a. High School transcripts (unofficial are accepted) or
  - b. Yavapai College Transcripts (unofficial are accepted) or
  - c. ACT scores or

d. SAT scores

5. Submit your completed application materials in one packet electronically to:
