

GED TESTING PROOF OF IDENTITY REQUIRED

At least two forms of identification must be provided in AZ.

- 1) One form of ID must be from the primary list;
- 2) The second ID may be from either the primary or secondary list; or

The combination of forms must satisfy all GEDTS requirements of identity and eligibility which includes: name, address, photo, signature and date of birth.__ Nothing will be accepted from the Unacceptable list. If the two forms of identification or more together do not provide proof of eligibility and identity, testing may not occur. Identification must be presented at EVERY test center visit.

PRIMARY IDENTIFICATION

- Current Driver's License or State-issued Identification card.
(ID may be from any state as long as it's valid; AZ ID card may be obtained through AZ Dept. of Motor Vehicles.)
- Valid passport (may be foreign or domestic)
- Military ID
- Other forms of government-issued (foreign, domestic, tribal) ID
(Must show: Name, address, date of birth, signature and photograph)
- Current post-secondary (college) student ID
(Must show: Name, address, date of birth, signature and photograph)

SECONDARY IDENTIFICATION

- Certified copy of Birth Certificate (when combined with any valid photo ID)
- Social Security card (when combined with any valid photo ID)
- AZ DPS Class one/Class two Fingerprint Card (when combined with any valid photo ID)
- Credit cards (credit cards with photo may be used as a secondary ID)
- Bank cards (bank cards with photo may be used as a secondary ID)
- High School student ID (may be combined with other forms of photo ID and used as a secondary ID)
- Workplace ID (ID cards with photo may be used as a secondary ID)

ATTENTION!

Outdated identification or identification suspected of being forged will not be accepted. Identification suspected of being forged will be reported to the authorities.

When a Chief Examiner or their designee has reasonable doubts concerning the validity of a candidate's identification, they have the right to question that candidate and to withhold the candidate's admission and testing until such time as any questions have been answered and doubts resolved.

- Check cashing ID cards
- Tourist cards
- Costco cards
- Library cards
- Insurance cards
