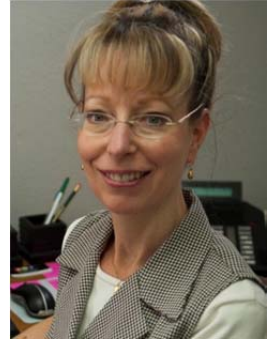
Linda Buchanan

Jeanne Welch

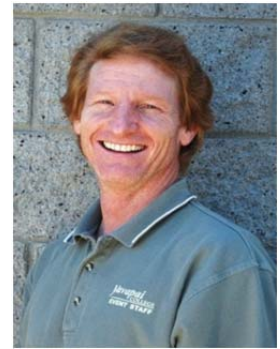
