2013-2014 Ownership Linkage and Common Threads Summary

Ownership Linkage Plan

The Yavapai College District Governing Board developed the Ownership Linkage 2013-2014 Plan as follows:

- Governance Process Policy 3.2.1 Ownership Linkage ownership linkage shall be the link between the organization and its ownership who are the residents of Yavapai County and those who are affected by Yavapai College. (Revised and adoption 9/19/2013)
- Goals are to be accountable, create a future (considering owner's needs, concerns, and demands), clarify values (Ends and Executive Limitations), educate, and build relationships with owners.

Outreach Results

Throughout the year, the District Governing Board used various outreach tools to implement 2013-2014 Ownership Linkage Plan. Detailed citizens' concerns were discovered through the following input and feedback opportunities:

- Owners Survey 1655 responses
- Open Call 39 citizens/5 regular meetings
- Focus Groups two sessions

Common Threads

Ownership feedback provided the following common threads:

- Ownership is in strong agreement with the Board Ends of Education, Economic Development, and Cultural enrichment—especially Education.
- Ownership participates in college services at higher levels than peer institutions, and is very satisfied with those services though less satisfied with Economic Development support.
- East County residents request more services (Community Events) and programs (Nursing, Film, CTE).
- East county residents would like improved schedules, with more face to face classes at VVC.
- Ownership requests improved Marketing and PR to learn more about classes, services, and amenities offered through YC.
- East County residents are concerned about the equitable spending of tax dollars throughout the district.
- Ownership expressed desire for continued support of Arts classes and programming.
- Ownership requests that YC offer affordable, local, quality education and related services.
