Planned gifts to Yavapai College Foundation will make a key difference in the College's ability to deliver high quality educational programs for students in our communities. Some recent donors gave the following reasons for their gifts:

- We have made a good living in Yavapai County and want to give back
 to Yavapai College for all the benefits our family received through the
 years. We also want to demonstrate to our daughter the importance
 of making philanthropic gifts in her community. We changed our
 will so that now, after all our family needs are met, we can make an
 unrestricted, significant gift to Yavapai College for their best use.
- In my husband's memory our family is creating the Mr. X Education Scholarship with a gift of \$20,000 to award an annual \$1,000 educational student scholarship. We are also donating \$2,000 in memorial gifts we received from our friends to jump start the fund to award scholarships for the next two years.
- We recently moved here from another state and have attended a
 few events in the Performing Arts Center. We have no children and
 don't want to leave all our assets to our nieces and nephews. We
 want to support education, the arts and animals, so after some small
 gifts to family, the remaining two-thirds will go to Yavapai College for
 Community Events/PACE and educational scholarships and one-third
 going to the Humane Society.
- We have it to share, and feel an obligation to improve the lives of others. We want to make a meaningful gift to Yavapai College as a benefactor of our Charitable Remainder Trust.
- I have little to give, but I wanted to make a gift to the Keubler Scholarship fund, so I took out a life insurance policy and named Yavapai College as the beneficiary.
