VVBAC Recommendations:

- 1. College do a better job of providing education in the Verde Valley
- 2. College do a better job of student recruitment
 - a. Create an annual recruitment plan
 - b. Provide larger staff with time and skills to work with Verde Valley school districts, Yavapai-Apache Nation, charter schools, and home-schooled students
 - c. Build awareness of the availability & advantages of YC
 - d. Visiting elementary & middle schools beginning with 3rd graders
 - e. Seek out each high school student wants and aptitude and provide (if possible) these courses
 - f. Present two-year certification programs to high school students
 - g. Create and maintain strong relationship with student and parents from 3rd grade through high school
- 3. College address the transportation barriers for students
 - a. Across the mountain
 - b. Within the Verde Valley
- 4. The Board delay approval of the FY 2015-2016 and FY 2016-2017 budget until a complete strategic plan is completed with VVBAC input
