- Arnhem and the History of World War II

April 23 - Middelburg

- Delta Works Experience and Veere Walking Tour

 - Middelburg features historic merchant houses and storefronts lining its canals
- In the afternoon, drive to the Delta Works project located at Neeltje Jans and enjoy a Veere Walking Tour
 - The Delta project is considered one of the engineering marvels of the world
 - Stop at the lovely town of Veere, one of the most picturesque towns in the area
- *OR* choose the Middelburg Walking Tour
 - Middelburg is full of monuments such as the powerful abbey, the impressive town hall and splendid old warehouses
- Relax on board in the evening, enjoying a delicious dinner as your vessel cruises onwards to the next destination

April 24 - Ghent

- Ghent and Granvensteen Medieval Fortress
- Bruges – Venice of the North
- *OR* Belgium Beer and Chocolate Tasting



- In the morning, discover Ghent, an attractive city with a rich heritage of medieval buildings
 - Visit Gravensteen, or “Castle of the Counts,” which was the residence of the Counts of Flanders until 1353
- In the afternoon, explore Bruges, known as the “Venice of the North”
 - Walk along the maze of winding, cobbled alleys, and romantic canals, and be transported to medieval times
- *OR* choose a Belgium Beer and Chocolate Tasting
 - Indulge your passion for sweets with a visit to one of Belgium's chocolatiers
 - Beer has been brewed in Belgium from the 12th century. Visit a local brewery to learn more about the history of beer and enjoy a tasting
- Relax on board in the evening, enjoying a delicious dinner as your vessel cruises onwards to the next destination

April 25 - Antwerp

- Brussels: Atomium & Cinquantenaire Park
- *AND* Antwerp with Cathedral of Our Lady



- After breakfast, experience the culturally significant city of Brussels
 - Explore the iconic Atomium and the Cinquantenaire Park with its triumphal arch
 - Tour the Verdant Laken area and landmarks such as the Heysel stadium, Notre Dame of Laken, the royal residence, and walk through Europe's oldest shopping mall
- In the afternoon, explore Antwerp and the Cathedral of Our Lady with paintings by the famous Baroque artist Peter Paul Rubens
 - Walk through the old city center and visit the Onze-Lieve-Vrouwe Cathedral (Cathedral of Our Lady), the largest Gothic church in Belgium
 - Enjoy some free time to explore this wonderful city with its lively shopping scene
- Relax and enjoy a delicious dinner with your fellow guests, while your vessel returns to the Netherlands

April 26 - Rotterdam

- Kinderdijk and the Windmills
- *OR* Harbor Cruise and Culinary Stroll
- Keukenhof Flower Gardens
- *OR* Royal Porcelain Pottery



- After breakfast, visit Kinderdijk, the most unique windmill complex in the world
 - Explore well-preserved windmills, built around 1740, and visit one of the old mills to learn about the past and changes due to modern technology
- *OR* take the Harbor cruise and discover local culinary delicacies in the Market Hall
 - Discover the largest seaport in Europe and tour the unique Market Hall for a diverse range of products
- After lunch, explore the famous Keukenhof gardens
 - Enjoy endless flowerbeds of millions of tulips, narcissi and hyacinths
 - Walk among the numerous sculptures to feel the harmony between art and nature
- *OR* take a tour to the lovely canal town of Delft, renowned for its Delft Blue Ceramics
 - One of the oldest Dutch cities, Delft holds numerous historical sites.
 - We will make a visit to the famous porcelain manufactory, Royal Delft, famous for the Delft Blue Porcelain since 1653
- Relax and enjoy a delicious dinner with your fellow guests, while your vessel returns to the Netherlands
