A Note from the Nursing Program Director

Welcome nursing students to the fall semester. Currently there are 197 enrolled nursing program students. There are program nursing students at Prescott and Verde Valley locations, including a new cohort of 48 first semester students! Yavapai College (YC) Nursing graduates continue to be successful on the Arizona NCLEX-RN Licensure with a pass rate of 97% in the first quarter of 2019, and 90% in the second quarter of 2019*. The YC NCLEX – RN national pass rate for 2019 is 90% * surpassing the national pass rate of 86%.

Currently, according to Arizona Board of Nursing there are 94,936 RN's practicing in Arizona. An increased demand for RNs in Arizona's future to be 28,000 more needed by 2025*.

Located on *myYC* for student review is BSN Concurrent Enrollment Programs (CEP) and BSN completion information regarding articulation transfer opportunity agreements with University of Phoenix, ASU, NAU, GCU, and many others with options that best fit student schedules. New this fall:

Castle Branch requirements

CPR and TB renewals must be completed <u>prior to semester start</u> if the expiration date will occur during the semester

Fall 2019 semester dates: August 19- December 13

Spring 2020 semester dates: January 13- May 8

If the expiration date needs to be re-set to allow you to upload the renewal of your CPR certification or TB test results, please call **Castle Branch customer service at 1-888-723-4263.** A new renewal date request will take 24-72 hours to be completed in the Castle Branch system. Please plan accordingly.

Fingerprint Clearance Cards are now part of your Castle Branch tracker. A copy of the front and back of the card must be uploaded as one document.

Flu immunizations for the 2019/2020 flu season must be available for review in your Castle Branch account by October 15, 2019. **For students who did not receive an immunization for the 2018/2019 season**, the immunization is required <u>prior to clinical orientation paperwork submission deadlines</u>.

Make sure to check all your requirements to verify all documentation is approved and current through the semester. A copy of your current Castle Branch "**To Do List Summary**" report indicating Nursing Program **Compliance** must be submitted to my office no later than August 26, 2019 (if you have not taken care of it already).

We are excited to announce we are implementing another multilevel simulation experience for Fall 2019 semester for students who missed a clinical day; the date is yet to be determined but will be held in December on the Prescott campus for both Prescott and Verde students who missed clinical. The feedback from students who attended the Spring 2019 multilevel simulation was overwhelmingly positive, and promoted a sense of collegiality and pride for those in attendance.

The simulation committee has been working on a simulation policy for both students and faculty. Students can expect to see changes starting Fall 2019, with clearly defined expectations and objectives for our simulation experiences (please reference the Nursing Program Student Handbook). The faculty have chosen Zigmont's 3D Model of Debriefing as the guide to help deepen the experience of simulation for students and to help foster a safe learning environment. ATI Integration

ATI Nursing Educational Resources are used throughout the Nursing Program, in every semester and is required for all nursing program students.

Students have a wealth of resources to support and supplement their learning through utilization of the ATI Resources.

Students purchase the online materials and resources through ATI 1-800-367-4762. The materials are financial aid-able. Students are required to purchase their ATI materials in order to maintain enrollment in their nursing program courses. Students that have not purchased their materials within one week of the course start date will not be permitted to progress in the course.

ATI will provide the access code directly to the student.

Students should direct ATI Resource questions to their course/clinical Nursing Instructor; the Nursing Instructor will be very helpful. The fee amount will be specific to the semester of the nursing program student.

On 5/29/19, all students were sent an email to their YC email address from the Nursing Office, announcing ATI Integration with helpful instructions for gaining access to ATI products and resources.

ATI student orientation and informational meetings are scheduled August 19th, 8 – 5 on Prescott, August 22nd 8 – 5 on Verde. ATI representatives will be visiting classrooms and will also be available for Q & A in dedicated spaces on each campus.
