# A Note from the Director of Nursing

Welcome nursing students to the Spring 2023 semester. Currently there are approximately 200 students enrolled in the nursing program at the Prescott and Verde Valley locations, including a new cohort of 50 first semester students! Yavapai College (YC) Nursing graduates continue to be successful on the NCLEX-RN Licensure with a first-time pass rate of 89.77% for 2022\*(total of four quarters) surpassing the 84.78% pass rate for the state of Arizona and 79.97% pass rate nationally.

Yavapai College is ranked 12th out of 34 nursing schools across Arizona according to www.registerednursing.org. This ranking is based on current and historical NCLEX pass rates.

Currently, according to Arizona Board of Nursing there are 107,131 RN's practicing in Arizona (Newsletter, Nov 2022). An increased demand for RNs in Arizona's future estimates 28,000 more needed by 2025\*. Job Placement Rates for graduates in 2021\* was 94%; 2022 data is still being processed.

The Nursing Program Student Handbook for 2022-2023 is available for students to review. Students are responsible each semester for knowing and following the contents of the most current Nursing Program Student Handbook and to review all YC e-NEWSFLASH communications.
