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**EXPENSES**

Mortgage \$1,700 ( 4 BR house ) \*\*\* includes taxes and home owners insurance.

2 – 3 women per room, separate room for the house manager.

Utilities: APS \$100 – 300 \*\*\* depends on the time of year.

Water/Sewer/Trash \$150

Gas \$40

Trash \$17

**\$2,107**

**INCOME**

\$130 per week, per woman (excluding the house manager)

\$ 130 x 4 = 520 per woman, per month.

\$ 520 x 7 = **\$3,640 per month**

\$ 1,200 - \$ 2,500 Church Donations

\$ Bi-Annual benefit dinner open to community Support

- ▶ Information & assistance on securing government grants.
- ▶ Mentorship regarding how to structure and start this home.
- ▶ Funding for the purchase of a home or capital to use towards a down payment of at least 20% of the purchase price.
