Sedona Beer Company utilizes <u>Squarrels</u> instead of traditional barrels to save wood and water. Squarrels use 1/3 the wood of a traditional barrel. Which is the exact amount of wood a barrel needs to provide equivalent micro-oxygenation to a traditional barrel of the same volume.


