## Vice President's update - Shannon Johns

## Policy Review Committee

- Gov board is coming out with new policies, so ELT is looking into which policies need to be sunset and which are still relevant or need separate policies vs procedures.
- o Human Resources is moving YC policies into a different tool called Policy Stat.
- o If we have any policy suggestion or changes, please send them to Julie.

# • Strategic Planning Committee

- Currently 17 people are reviewing each other's strategic plans
- o In the 10/5/21 meeting the team discussed: Retention, IT, and Recruitment Strategic Plans.
- The Strategic plan for 25% enrollment on Hispanic ethnicity is currently at 23%. With the new request for updating ethnicity in progress this goal could be met.

## **ELT Update – Emily Weinacker**

- Emily discussed the proposed new annual increase idea of Gainshare
  - Last April Gov board approved across the board 3% raises. However, some members indicated they would not continue to support future increases. The board discussed pay for performance and merit increases as possible ways to justify increases.
  - The ELT is moving forward a discussion of a different method of determining annual increases which need board approval each year.
  - One proposal is called Gainsharing which attaches compensation to strategic goal attainments.
  - Emily suggested we could set meets or exceeds target goals in which employees could get increases or bonuses depending on which strategic assigned goals were met. The more goals met the higher increase.
  - Emily asked the group for suggestion on what measures the team would like to see to be introduced with the proposal for Governing Board consideration.
  - When YCSA last discussed, suggested ideas were 4% to include a 2% cost of living raise with an additional incentive of 2% available for meeting the selected strategic goals. This idea is being considered by ELT.
  - Emily suggested incentives could include Enrollment, Retention, or Completions.
  - o Emily asked what we think about the Gainshare proposal?



- The group discussed how they see this Gainshare idea and how it would impact each area.
- Concerns from members included that some employees have more of a community member focus rather than a student focus, so the concern would be they would impact some of the college goals for impact students.
- Emily challenges each team member to think about how they could contribute to meeting the college goals.
- The team will think of ways they can be in a support position for impacting students to meet the college Gainshare goals for future discussion.

## **Budget Request progress – Lee Ann Walker**

- Winter celebration Committee: the budget is currently being developed
- Professional Development Committee reported there is no need for a budget at this time.
- Professional Growth Committee will create a budget to send to Emily for use of Professional Development funds ear marked for college wide needs.
