Pathways Symposium at Pasadena City College:

Tania and Barb Waak summarized some of the PCC Pathways program.

- Working on Pathways for 15 years
- Built Student Support side first
- Use priority registration to interest students in Pathways
- PCC has 30,000 students; 2400 in Pathways
- College 1 class critical thinking; cross cultural diversity; Common Read 76 sections offered; everyone in Pathways takes this class
- 83% students in Pathways full time
- Students came up with phrase: Get In, Get Out, Get Going

SLOA Day – Pathways sessions:

Committee members that attended shared some comments.

- Lot of different thoughts on where to place Gen Eds on flow chart
- Some thought two flow charts needed: Cert path; AAS path with Gen Eds, Cert embedded
- Program faculty need to understand Gen Ed needs and Gen Ed faculty need to understand Program needs
- Lists of classes have some that haven't been offered in long time. Deans have review process that if not offered in three years, course goes inactive
- Lot of discussion on Gateway courses
- Faculty need to look at transfer needs of students
- Friday session was just the beginning; need a lot of review of flow charts

Future Actions:

- Flow charts need to be done electronically by department
- Flow charts with transfer degrees department needs to confirm university preferences of Gen Eds; university transfer needs
- Need to figure out process/structure of how flow charts will get uploaded to websites and kept up-to-date and all parts of website that will need to be updated when curriculum changes
- Suggestion of Pathways website might be best way to communicate with committee, faculty
- Faculty need to look at common courses within program of study
- Need to look at Critical Thinking courses
- Might be helpful to have Gen Ed Committee review class lists
