Blackboard on the iPad

Blackboard works normally when accessed through the Safari browser on the iPad, with a few notable exceptions:

1. The Java text editor with all the formatting options above the window does not allow one to type into it, so new text items, descriptions, and discussion threads can't be created. THE SOLUTION is to turn off the text editor. To do so:

1. Turn the Visual Editor button above the text box to Off.
