

General Field Trip/Event Expectations

Yavapai College sponsors field trips and special events for students as a means of providing a complementary and diverse learning environment. Field trip/event participants and leaders should conduct themselves in a professional and positive manner as representatives of Yavapai College. All students must adhere to and are responsible for the <u>Student Code of Conduct</u> as part of their enrollment at Yavapai College and participation on the field trip.

- Follow instructor/staff directives, operating guidelines and instructions. Failure to comply
 with instructor/staff directives, engaging in prohibited conduct, or violation of any laws
 may result in disciplinary and/or legal action. Behavior that interferes with this learning
 opportunity is unacceptable and will result in students being discharged from the field
 trip/event (responsible for own transportation home), dropped from the class or expelled
 from the college.
- Anyone with a history of medical conditions should consult with their physician prior to the
 field trip activity to be sure that they are in condition to make the trip or participate in the
 event. Any prescription medications required should be in the original container clearly
 indicating the patient and medication information. Be sure to take sufficient quantity for
 the duration of the event.
- In the interest of communication and preparedness students should share their Field
 Trip/Event itinerary with their designated contact person, particularly departure and arrival times.
- The field trip/event lasts from the designated start time until its designated conclusion.
- Participation is limited to students registered in the class or program sponsoring the field trip/event.
- Field trips provide a unique learning opportunity; students should come with an open mind, a spirit of cooperation, and a sense of curiosity about the experience to make the most of this activity.
- Any activity(s) that can result in injury, due to the nature or the activity(s), are voluntary and not required.
- When travel that occurs out of country, students will be expected to not only abide by the laws of Arizona and the USA, but also the laws of the locality they are in.
- Alcohol/Marijuana and Other Drug Use. The possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages, marijuana (whether medical or recreational) or illegal drugs on any College campus, College-owned property, or College-sponsored activity is prohibited. Regardless of age, the College prohibits students, employees, and visitors from being impaired by alcohol, marijuana, or illegal drugs while at any College sponsored activity.



Field Trip/Event Consent Form

Every student participating in a college-sponsored trip must read the field trip/event expectations and sign the field trip consent form prior to the departure of a field trip or the beginning of an event. Participation is limited to students registered in the class or program sponsoring the field trip/event. I accept full responsibility for the liability of myself and my passengers, and I understand that if I am a passenger in such a private vehicle, Yavapai College and its personnel are not in any way responsible for the safety of such transportation and that Yavapai College insurance does not cover any damage or injury suffered in the course of traveling in such a vehicle. In the event of any



medical attention is needed, I authorize the leader(s) of the field trip/event or any qualified individual to administer the first aid necessary to maintain health until a physician may be reached or other medical assistance obtained. I further authorize any physician to administer such medical or surgical treatment as necessary.
