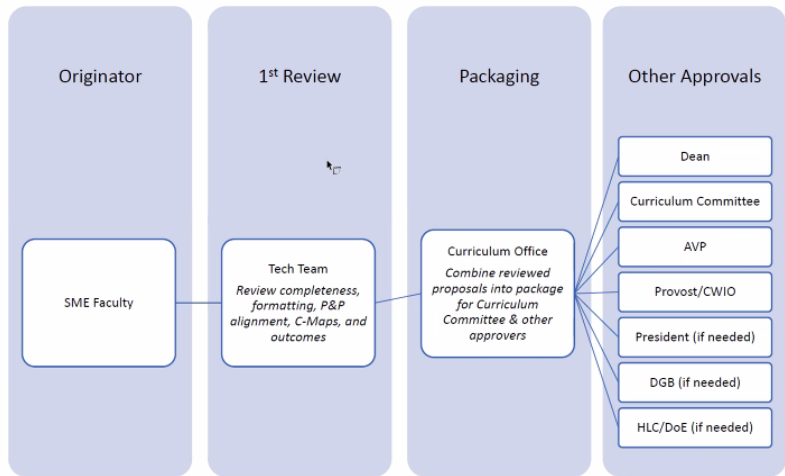

 - b. Bachelor of Science vs. Bachelor of Applied Science vs. Bachelor of Arts

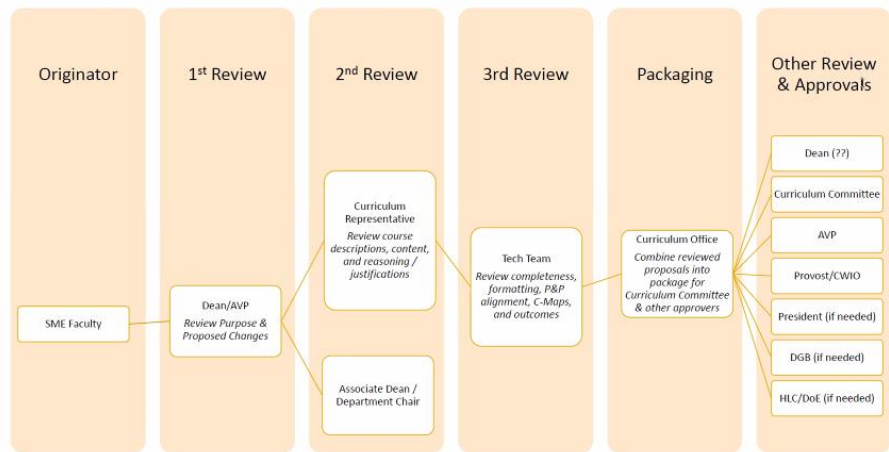
- i. Lindsay shared <https://online.uc.edu/blog/ba-vs-bs-which-is-the-better-business-degree-uc-online/>
