
BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS PLANNED MAINTENANCE PROJECTS

As part of the budget, planned maintenance projects are scheduled each year to ensure that College facilities are maintained at a level that supports optimum performance in building systems and infrastructure, life safety compliance, adequate maintenance and repair of roadways, parking lots, and College grounds. These projects result from a recent Facilities Condition Assessment (FCA), which identifies when repairs, modifications, or replacement of components should occur.



FY23-24 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

Health Sciences Center at Prescott Valley

The project design is due to be completed on March 21; however, the new Health Sciences Center will be placed on hold until funding is secured, possibly in fiscal year 2027. The plan was to use State and Federal funds to supplement Yavapai College's capital. However, these additional funding sources are no longer available.


FLOOR PLAN








MICTED/YC Culinary


Emergency Preparedness
