Section 1: Accident/Incident Reporting (All Individuals)

What should I do if I am injured on campus?

- Report the injury immediately.
- If life-threatening, call 911. Campus Safety is automatically notified.
- Complete an [Accident/Incident Report Form](#) within 24 hours with the assistance of Campus Safety or YC staff, even if medical treatment is not needed.

Where do I send the report?

Employees/Volunteers	Students/Visitors
Complete the form electronically. It will automatically be routed to HR.	Complete the report electronically. It will automatically be routed to HR and Campus Safety.

Section 2: Students and Visitors – Additional Information

- Reporting an incident creates a record but does not initiate an insurance claim automatically.
- Medical care and expenses are the responsibility of the individual unless a claim is approved.

- Contact Alliance On Call Triage Nurse at (888) 252-4689 (option 3).
- Use an authorized NextCare treatment provider (listed below) for initial evaluation.
- Seek emergency care if outside the area, then follow up with an authorized provider listed below.

Section 4: Filing a Workers’ Compensation Claim

- Ensure all forms from the provider are completed promptly.
- The treating physician must submit reports to the Industrial Commission of Arizona and The Alliance.
- Provide HR and your supervisor with work status updates.
- Follow all requirements for modified duty and treatment.
