

## Cognos FAQ

### What is Cognos?

Cognos an IBM software product is web-based for creating and managing ad hoc and custom-made reports. It is a reporting tool, which accesses data from Banner and ODS tables to generate reports.

### What is the recommended browser for running Cognos reports?

Cognos 10.2.1 supports IE versions:

IE 6.0, 7.0, 8.0, 9.0, 11.0 (and future fix packs for all IE version listed)

Note: IE 11 Supported in Compatibility mode only.

### What do I do if my report runs indefinitely?

Try login off of Cognos and resubmitting your report. If the problem persists, contact Leo Derks (IER). You can also run your report to send the output results to your email once it has completed. For instructions to run report with options, please refer to the Cognos training manual on this web page.

### Why is the web page blank after running a report?

To allow your report to display in a pop-up window, sometimes Internet explorer requires you to hold down the CTRL key when running reports formatted for Excel. If the problem persists, contact Leo Derks (IER).
