How Payroll is Determined



You are paid according to load hours, which are different than credit hours. One lecture hour = 1 load, one lab hour varies depending on the type of lab: .7 for PHE/REC/Activity Based Dance; 1 load for Science Labs; .75 for all other lab-based courses.

A load hour = \$989.00. Here are a few examples:
