




Rank your preferred class format:


Rank the most favorable times of day for classes:



I think the variety and number of classes that have been offered before is wonderful. I am amazed and grateful.


What length of session (fall, winter etc) do you prefer (choose 1):


Have you participated in a social event in the last year? (Zoom Birthday, Trivia, Mardi Gras, Holiday Party)


Suggestions for Social Events
