TRANSFER RESOURCES

You will be considered a transfer student for admissions purposes if you have completed 12 or more transferable, post-high school college credits. If you have earned less than 12 credits, you will be considered a first-year applicant. **It is recommended that you apply for admissions at least one semester before your intended enrollment start term.**

Admissions Requirements under the age of 22

- At least a 2.0 cumulative college/university GPA
- Arizona Board of Regents (ABOR) course competencies

Admissions Requirements 22 or Older

- At least a 2.0 cumulative college/university GPA

Transfer Scholarships



**2.5 GPA
\$2,000**

- 2.50 GPA at the time of your application.
- Completed a minimum 36 transferable units.
- Completed a maximum of 80 transferable units.
- Must have attended at least 1 Arizona Community College post-HS.
- Must be an Arizona Resident.



**3.0 GPA
\$3,000**

- 3.00-4.00 GPA at the time of your application.
- Completed a minimum 36 transferable units.
- Completed a maximum of 80 transferable units.



**3.5 GPA
\$5,000**

- 3.50- 4.00 GPA at the time of your application.
- Must be a member of PTK (PTK membership shown on official transcript or sent to your Admissions Counselor).
- Completed a minimum 36 transferable units (no maximum).

To be eligible for any Transfer Merit Scholarships the applicant must have only attended community college(s) post-HS. (**NO** university attendance). Transfer Merit Scholarships cannot be combined/stacked..
