- The Residence Halls received upgraded washers and dryers for the resdients!






Residence Life Staff Updates:

On March 14th, Deborah Chambers and Jeremy Poehnert attended the St. Mary's Food Bank, Partner agency Annual Conference in Flagstaff, Arizona. The conference was held at Twin Arrows Navajo Hotel and Casino. There were lots of great networking opportunities as well as activities, and workshops.

Chief Program's Officer, Marcos Gaucin gave the keynote speech and shared that St. Mary's delivered **110,427,000** pounds of food in Arizona in 2022. **9,000,000** of the total food came to Yavapai County.
