## **YC Food Pantry**

On March 28<sup>th</sup> the Yavapai College Food Pantry in collaboration with St. Mary's Food Bank hosted a **Community Mobile Food Distribution**. Community members were invited to come to campus and pick up meat, vegetables, fruit, dairy, bread and snacks. **132** vehicles picked up food for **238** households that fed **626** community members. **49** Yavapai College staff, faculty, students and student athletes helped distribute **8,679** lbs of food. These numbers exceeded our distribution last semester. The YC Food Pantry will distribute more food to the community in October.
