

OLLI CODE OF BEHAVIOR

All members and staff of OLLI will be treated with courtesy and respect. Threatening or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. This behavior includes excessive class interruption, monopolizing class time, verbal and written abuse, obscene or profane language toward another member, excessive chattiness, cell phone use, not respecting the opinions of others, and other behaviors that disturb facilitators, members and staff.

Whenever possible, disturbances should be dealt with in a tactful, private and gentle manner trying to avoid embarrassment for the parties involved. The member creating a disturbance shall be warned and informed of expected behavior and the consequences of continued misbehavior. If the problem is not resolved using a one-on-one approach, then the member may ask the help of a committee or council member to help resolve the issue. If no resolution is reached, the member will submit an incident report to the OLLI staff as a matter of record. Continued offenses may result in temporary or permanent banning from a particular class or OLLI membership.
