To move-out of the halls please:

- Drop off your room and mail key at the drop box in Marapai Hall

You will be considered having moved out of your room completely once all of your items have been removed from your room and we receive your room key. If you do not have your room key, please contact Residence Life right away to let us know - residence.life@yc.edu.

What if I've already moved out of the halls?

If you've already removed all of your items AND turned in your key, there is nothing else you need to do. If you've removed your items but not returned your key, simply return your key to us.

You can return your key in person by dropping it off at the key box in Marapai lobby, or mail it to Residence Life. If you are mailing your key, please tape it to a card with your name on it, put it in an envelope and mail it to the address below. Please also email us to let us know the day that you mailed it - residence.life@yc.edu.

Keys sent by mail must be received by Monday, April 6. Residence Life is not responsible for keys that are mailed but not received.

Items left in rooms

Any items left in rooms after students move-out and/or the halls close will be disposed of in accordance with college policy.

Will I get a refund?

Any resident who completes the check-out process and moves out of the halls by March 29th will get a refund of 50% of the costs paid directly by them for room and meals for this semester. The exact amount of the room and meals refund each student receives will be impacted by any specific financial aid or scholarships they have received the semester.

Will I receive my housing deposit?

Students who move-out by March 29th are eligible to receive their housing deposit. The exact amount of the housing deposit returned to a student will depend on whether they return their key and any damages in their room. Housing deposits will be processed and returned after March 29th.
