



**LEGAL PARAPROFESSIONAL  
ARIZONA STATE REQUIREMENTS**

The following courses must be taken in order to meet the educational requirements required by the Arizona Supreme Court to practice as a Legal Paraprofessional in Arizona under ACJA 7-210. The Yavapai College Paralegal Studies Program offers all the courses required under Arizona law.

Students must be enrolled in Paralegal Studies AAS, or must have an Associate’s Degree in any subject and be enrolled in the Paralegal Studies Certificate program, to be eligible to take these courses. Additional credits are required for the Paralegal Studies AAS Degree or the Paralegal Studies Certificate.
