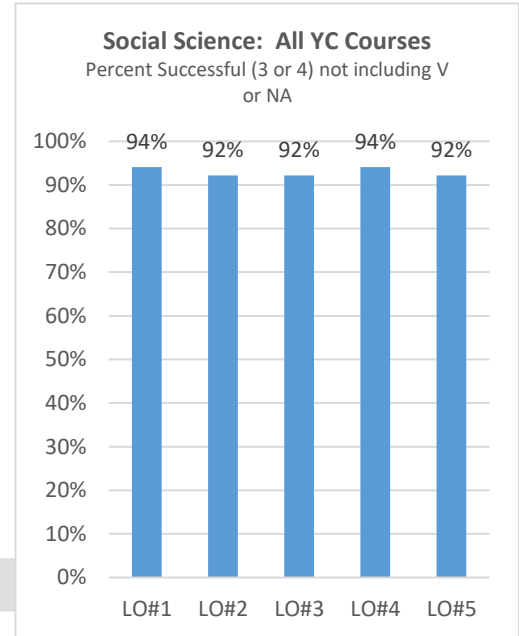
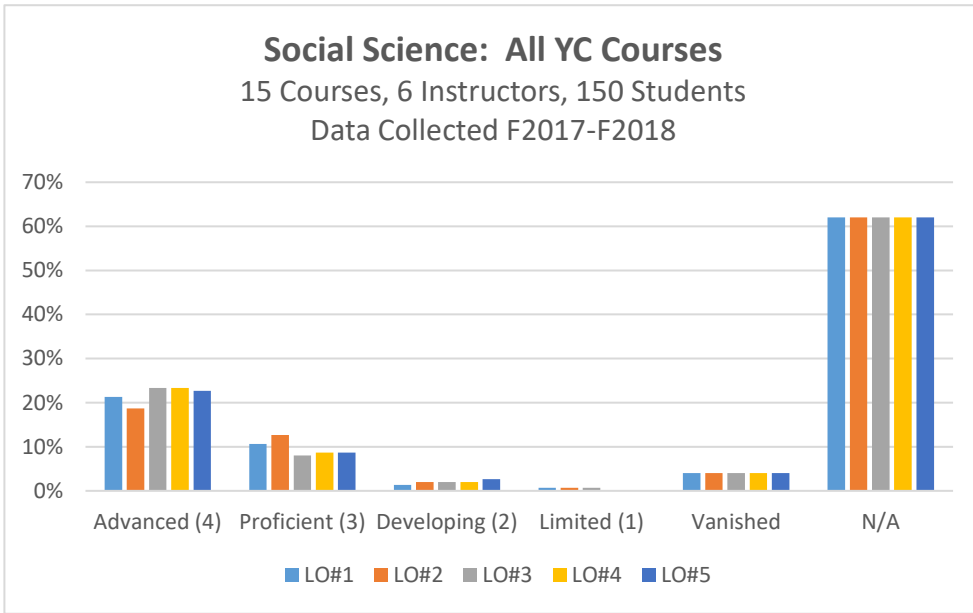
Social Science Outcomes and Rubric

Upon successful completion of the required number of courses on the Social Sciences Area List the learner will be able to:

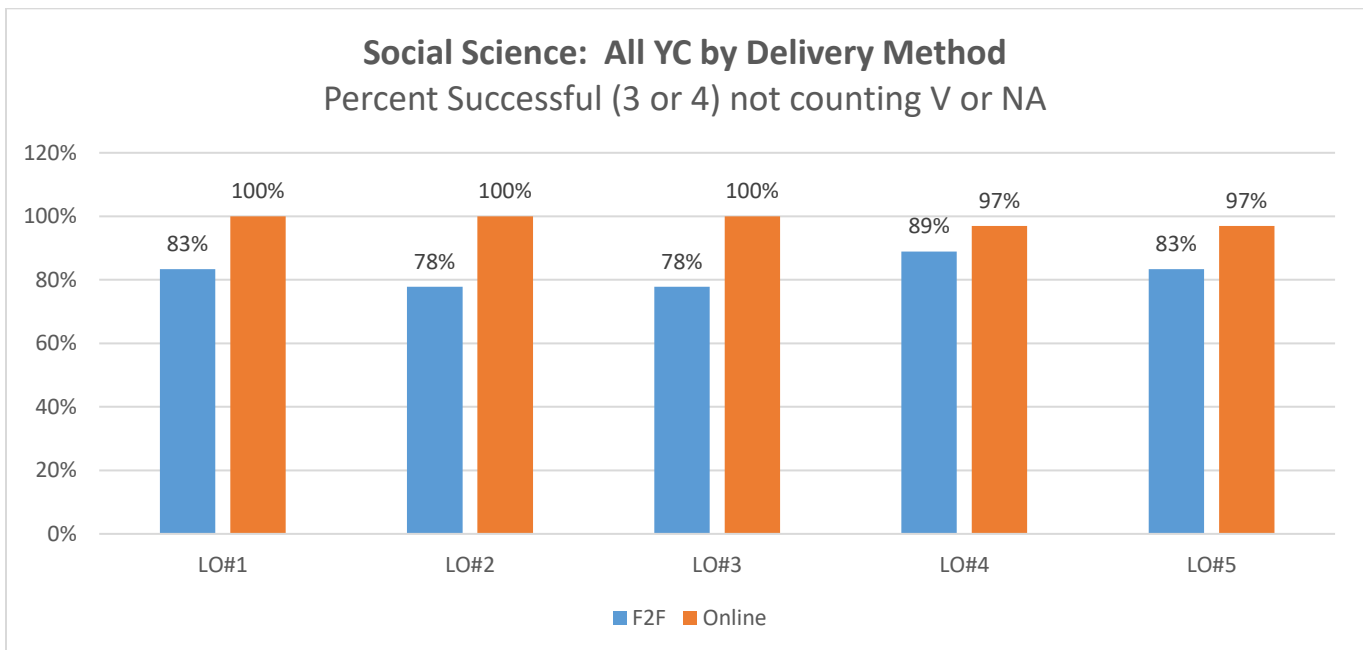
- LO #1: Evaluate the relevant perspectives, paradigms, arguments, theories or interpretations in the social sciences.
