Ginney Bilbray - Strategic Planning

- HR work: 4-year degree staffing, new occupational faculty, and wage scale annual compensation
- SCM working on stopouts, return on investments to students, increasing digital advertising/social media
- Fundraising plan for YC Foundation will be due at the end of February
- Received a presentation from Dr. Ryan, but it was cut short
 - o Increasing faculty, outreach program, expanding workforce development
 - o College is focusing on getting students ready instead of expecting students to be ready

Sarah Southwick – Gen Ed

- Working on AGEC redesign; gathering feedback from faculty due at end of March
- Easy transfer has a presentation so you can look at the criteria; must provide a submission about what we want to say about the criteria to easy transfer provide feedback to Karen Palmer
- Jessica Gaff attending Easy Transfer summit in April, will share information with the committee

Karen Vail – Assessment
